

LPG GAS CYLINDERS

- 14 **CHECK** for leaks after fitting new cylinders and before lighting. They can be detected by sound, smell or the use of soapy water.
- 15 If gas has leaked allow it to disperse before attempting to light the equipment.
- 16 If there is a smell of gas after lighting turn off gas immediately and investigate.
- 17 Dispose of the empty gas cylinders **CAREFULLY**, they can explode if thrown on a fire.

PARAFFIN

- 18 Keep the fuel container well clear of the area to be burnt.
- 19 **DO NOT** smoke when refuelling and turn off the flame.
- 20 Replace fuel caps securely on the flame gun and the fuel container. Wipe up any spillage immediately.
- 21 Fuel containers should be in good condition and leak proof.
