



- 16 **NEVER** place any gas bottle under or near a barbecue when in use, or subject any bottle to excessive heat or direct sunlight.
- 17 If a barbecue is not equipped with a bottle support, the bottle must be placed beside the barbecue at ground level.
- 18 **ALWAYS** keep the bottle securely fastened in an upright position.
- 19 **DO NOT** allow any hot material (grease) to fall on to the hose or allow the hose to come in contact with any hot surface of the barbecue.

20 **A leak test must be carried performed:**

- Before lighting the barbecue for the first time.
- Every time the gas bottle is refilled, or any gas component is changed.

21 **ENSURE** that the lava rock or ceramic briquettes are thoroughly dry before use.

22 **DO NOT** use charcoal; wood charcoal or coconut briquettes on the barbecue.

23 Lava rock or ceramic briquettes **MUST** be heated before the food is added.

**BARBECUES WITH VIEWING WINDOWS**

- The viewing window is normally made from tempered glass; the following will help prevent breakage.

24 When cleaning glass, use hot water and household cleaner.

25 **DO NOT** use an abrasive cleaner or sharp tools.

26 **DO NOT** operate the barbecue in heavy rain or where it may experience a sudden quenching action i.e. a lawn sprinkler.

27 **DO NOT** drop the lid when closing.

28 **AVOID** "grease fires" which can result in the flames impinging directly on to the glass.

29 **DO NOT** attempt repairs. Contact the Hire Company.
